OVERVIEW

GOLF COURSE

Designed by champion golfer, Peter Thomson, the par 71 championship Hamilton Island Golf Club on neighbouring Dent Island measures 6,120 metres (6692 yards). As the only championship island golf course in Australia, the course has been designed to challenge all levels of golf enthusiasts, from resort guests to professional golfers.

The changes in course elevation, restricted landing areas and the ever present breezes provide a definite challenge from the back tees and enjoyable resort golf from the forward markers.

The par 71, 18 hole course features two distinctly different nine hole circuits returning to a central clubhouse with panoramic views of Dent Passage and Hamilton Island. The outward nine holes are a more compact layout around the centre of the island and the inward nine are strung out along the ridges to the south.

The island's natural and rugged beauty, together with its mountainous terrain affords stunning 360 degree views across secluded coves and beaches to adjacent passages and islands, and the mainland beyond.

REGISTRATION

AMBROSE

Ambrose is the most common golf team competition (2, 3 or 4 person) used for golf events, where players play the best ball of a team member after every stroke until the ball is holed out at each hole.

It has a number of advantages including:

- Keeps the group together for the entire round and generates real team enthusiasm
- Allows for players of average or less than average ability to play without the embarrassment of holding up play. They can also contribute to the team score with the occasional good shot, putt or hole
- Helps to give a smooth and quicker round of golf
- Makes for a fun day for everyone regardless of his or her ability

TRANSFERS

Your golf experience begins when you board our custom built Hamilton Island Golf Club launch that can hold up to 50 guests. Leaving Hamilton Island Marina and Yacht Club behind, take in the awe inspiring beauty of the Whitsundays as you cruise your way across to Dent Island. At Dent Island you will be greeted at the Golf Club jetty and transferred up to the Clubhouse to begin your game on Australia's only island championship Golf Course.

The transfer takes approximately 10 minutes and departs daily from 8.00am and every hour after until 2.00pm.

Transfers depart Dent Island every hour on half past the hour.

PROPOSED ITINERARY

- 8.00am Transfer from Hamilton Island to Golf Club
- 8.15am Registration with refreshments
- 9.00am Briefing
- 9.15am Golf first tee time for group or shotgun start
- 1.30pm Lunch and prize presentation
- 5.00pm Close and transfer back to Hamilton Island



GREEN FEES

0 to 19 rounds:

9 holes - \$155 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

18 holes - \$215 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

20 to 40 rounds:

9 holes - \$139.50 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

18 holes - \$193.50 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

41 to 60 rounds:

9 holes - \$124 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

18 holes - \$172 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

61 plus:

9 holes - \$108.50 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

18 holes - \$150.50 per person (includes shared golf buggy and return Hamilton Island transfers)

SOLE USE (From 8.00am to 5.00pm)

Sole use of Hamilton Island Golf Course and the Clubhouse is available for a minimum spend of \$25,000 per day.

Groups of 40 or more will be required to have sole use. The golf course can accommodate a maximum 100 golfers per day (one round per person).

FERRY TRANSFERS

The return ferry transfer is included in the Hamilton Island Golf Green Fees. It is available for non golfers at \$30 per person.

The first ferry from Hamilton Island to Hamilton Island Golf Club is at 8.00am and the last ferry from Hamilton Island Golf Club to Hamilton Island is at 5.00pm.



NOVELTY EVENTS

NEAREST THE PIN

We have four par 3 holes where these can be played for on Holes 4, 7, 14 and 16. This can be separated into male and female events. A marker will be made up and taken on course by the Golf Operations Team to each chosen hole. Should a player hit the green then they can take the marker and write their name on it, have a playing partner sign this as a witness and then place it on the green at the point where their ball finished for their first shot. If other players hit their ball closer during the day then the other player(s) can place their name with a witness' signature on the marker and place it where their ball came to rest.

LONGEST DRIVE COMPETITION

This is quite often played on Hole 18 but can also be set up on Holes 1, 6 or 15. The competition can be separated into male and female divisions. A marker will be made up by the Golf Operations Team and placed at the tee of the chosen hole(s). Should a player hit the fairway they can take this marker and write their name on it, have a playing partner sign it as a witness and then place it where their drive has gone to. During the day if anyone outdrives this marker and is on the fairway, they can move the marker forward to their position and sign the marker as per the players before them.

STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FEES

Please note a 10% surcharge applies on Sundays and 15% on Public Holidays. A 1.25% surcharge applies to bill totals (inclusive of any applicable Sunday and public holiday surcharge) for all 'credit' and 'tap and go' transactions made via credit or debit card. Fee free payments can be made via EFTPOS by inserting your card and using a cheque and/or savings account at the terminal.

SOLE USE

Sole use fees, as noted throughout Hamilton Island's reception venue portfolios, are the minimum fees required to be paid to utilise the entire venue itself. These minimum fees as described can then be utilised towards the food and beverage component of the function. The sole use fee and minimum spend enables you to book that venue or area for your group only for the standard service period of that venue or area unless otherwise agreed upon in writing. Any shortfall in the use of that minimum spend amount will be forfeited by the client, and cannot be utilised for take away alcohol or be utilised outside the time period agreed upon in the sole use booking and standard agreed service period.

SERVICE PERIODS

Service periods are listed in each individual portfolio and are subject to change without notice and generally cannot be extended. Should an extension be obtained this may incur additional charges and can only be relied upon after written permission has been obtained from the venue manager by your coordinator.

CHAIRS

Many venues' standard chairs are not designed to fit chair covers and/or decorations. Where this is the case and chair covers are being utilised, Hamilton Island Golf Club chairs are the only chairs able to be utilised in the Golf Club and they do not fit standard chair covers. Purpose designed white chair covers are available at a separate cost above any minimum spend for any area arranged via your coordinator

FINAL NUMBERS

Guaranteed final numbers and signed final event order must be supplied to your coordinator no less than one 14 days prior to the function date. The minimum final number will dictate the final charge on the day/night.

LOCATION

If absolutely necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances and your function cannot be held in your chosen venue, the venue reserves the right to supply an alternate venue in its place. All additional costs incurred through the moving of the event will be covered by the venue. The venue will not be held liable for any costs or damages outside those directly incurred by the moving of the function. This condition is not relevant to functions which have been moved due to weather.

WET WEATHER

Where an outdoor venue is booked, a wet weather option will be chosen on your behalf by your coordinator where necessary. If, in the event of unfavourable weather, the wet weather option will require additional decoration and set up to make it look appropriate for your wedding reception or function, in all cases these additional requirements will be at your cost.

BEVERAGE SERVICE

In accordance with the Queensland Liquor Act, responsible service of alcohol is practiced in all venues. Alcohol will not be served to patrons under the age of 18 years or to intoxicated guests.

ENTERTAINMENT AND SPEECHES ETC

Entertainment can only be utilised for functions where the entire venue has been booked solely for your function, in all other cases, for the comfort of other resort guests no entertainment or music will be allowed. Other options such as speeches are allowed in non sole use venues however are to be conducted in a way which does not disturb other resort guests who may be utilising the same venue, and are to be pre arranged through your wedding consultant. No amplification of any kind is allowed in non-sole use venues. All Hamilton Island run venues have sound systems which cannot play standard or burnt CD's and cannot be connected to iPod's or mp3 players. For entertainments options, please contact your events coordinator

MENU OPTIONS

Adaptations and changes to set menus offered may be requested but cannot always be provided. All effort will be made to provide suitable dietary alternatives upon request no less than one month prior to the function date.

ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Your request for a booking at this venue is acceptance of these terms and conditions as set out here and as subject to change from time to time.

DAMAGES/CLEANING

Clients are financially responsible for any damages sustained to the venue and its contents and property, prior to, during and after the event by the client, guests or contractors engaged by the client. Clients are responsible for costs incurred due to excessive cleaning required of the venue caused by actions of the client, guests or contractors engaged by the client.

PUBLIC LIABILITY

The client needs to determine its public liability responsibilities for activities undertaken by the client, guests or contractors engaged by the client.

DISCOUNT CARDS/VOUCHERS/KIDS EAT FREE PROGRAM

No discount cards, vouchers or any other special offers are valid at any wedding reception or function. Kids Eat Free program does not apply to any wedding reception or function.
